One Health Day 2017 events planned by scientists, health practitioners/organizations and students demonstrate a tremendous global interest, need and call for health professionals to work together across disciplines.


[One Health Day](#) is an international campaign launched in November 2016, co-coordinated by the [One Health Commission](#), the [One Health Initiative Autonomous pro bono Team](#) and the [One Health Platform Foundation](#).

The goal of One Health Day is to bring attention around the world to the need for One Health interactions and for the world to 'see them in action'. The One Health Day campaign is designed to engage as many individuals as possible from as many arenas as possible in One Health education and awareness events, and to generate an inspiring array of projects worldwide.

Ethiopia: Government One Health Day Celebration

Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, November 3, 2017

Organizer: National One Health Steering Committee (NOHSC)

The Ethiopian government will hold a morning event aimed to promote the institutionalization of One Health in Ethiopia to be held at the Ethiopia Public Health Institute. Presentations will be made on global One Health initiatives and One Health work in Ethiopia followed by panel discussions. The NOHSC draws from the four core-government sectors including Ministry of Health (MoH), Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries (MoLF), Ministry of Culture and Tourism/Ethiopian Wildlife Conservation Authority (MoCT), and Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC). The event is expected to improve public awareness of the One Health concept by at all levels to support and promote One Health initiatives in the country.
