

**Dr Victor Del Rio Vilas** is a veterinary public health adviser within the Pan American Health Organization (PAHO), based in Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) with regional responsibilities. He advises Ministries/Departments of Health on epidemiology, surveillance and control measures for a number of diseases such as rabies, leishmaniasis, hidatidosis, and on existing and emerging zoonoses programmatic issues across the region. He has previously worked in Uzbekistan implementing the Biological Threat Reduction Program (Defense Threat Reduction Agency, US DoD), and as veterinary advisor and epidemiologist for UK's Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) and the Veterinary Laboratories Agency, respectively. He sits at the Board of Directors of the International Society for Disease Surveillance (ISDS) and co-chairs its Global Outreach committee.
