OH-SS Publications Working Group

Goal

- ❑ To communicate the relevance of integrating social sciences and OH approaches, and to disseminate good practices, benchmarks, and success stories



Rationale

- ❑ Although social sciences concepts and methods are directly relevant to OH approaches, there are relatively few publications in the evidence base on this topic. To address this gap, transdisciplinary collaborations that integrate social sciences and OH approaches will be key to advancing scientific discovery.



OH-SS Publications Working Group

Objectives

- ❑ To strengthen the network of scientists and practitioners who are interested to incorporate One Health and social science concepts and methods into their research and practice.
- ❑ To compile a comprehensive list of peer- and non-peer reviewed publications that would consider multidisciplinary scientific contributions.
- ❑ To foster scientific collaborations that can lead to co-authored submissions.



OH-SS Publications Working Group

Accomplishments (March–December 2018)

- ✓ Organized the participating PWG member list by discipline, geographic region, and OH interests.
- ✓ Prepared a quarterly timeline for the completion of the comprehensive list of publications.
- ✓ Identified scientific publications that are appropriate for future co-authored submissions.





