The ISID program, ProMED-mail, is a free Internet-based reporting system with 60,000+ subscribers dedicated to rapid global dissemination of information on outbreaks of infectious diseases and acute exposures to toxins that affect human health, including those in animals and in plants grown for food or animal feed. Moderated electronic communications enable ProMED-mail to provide up-to-date and reliable news about threats to human, animal, and food plant health around the world, 7 days a week.</p>
